

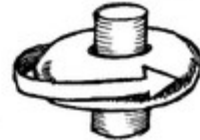
BEND THOSE BONES

The places where bones meet are called joints. Different joints do different things.

The elbow joint bends like a door hinge.



A pivot joint lets you turn your head from side to side.



A ball-and-socket joint lets you move your legs and arms in circles.



The longest, largest bone is your thighbone.
