This small bird is the state bird of California and is native to the southwestern part of the United States. Males have a black plume, dark brown cap, brown flanks with white streaks, gray-blue chest and light-brown belly. Females are mainly brown with a light-colored belly.

Common Kingfisher

This cute sparrow-sized bird can be found across Europe, Asia and Northern Africa. The bird has blue upperparts with a bright azure-blue back and rump, rufous patch by the bill base, and rufous ear-patch. It has a green-blue neck stripe, white neck blaze and throat and rufous underparts. Its bill is black with some red at the base and the legs are bright red.

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
