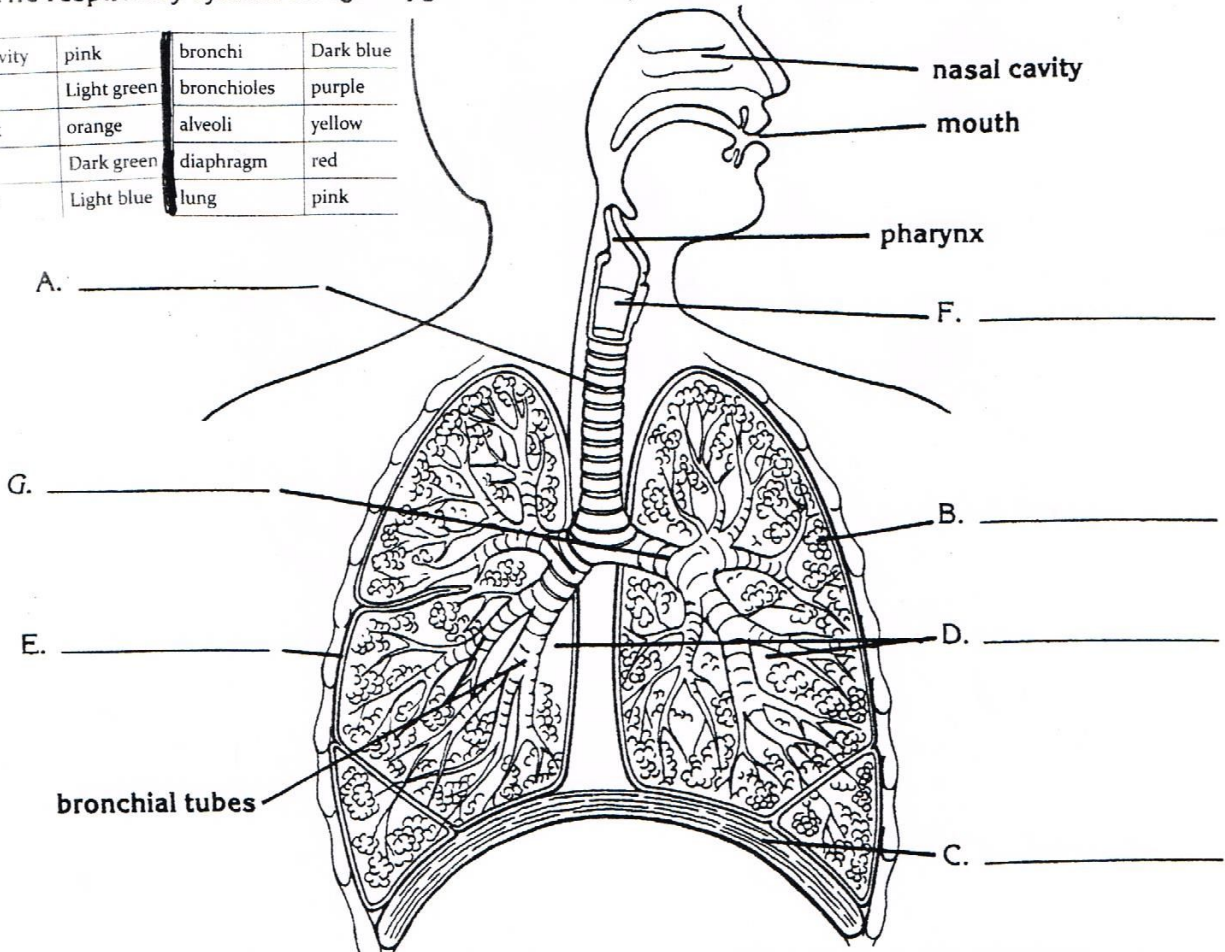


The Respiratory System

Nasal cavity	pink	bronchi	Dark blue
mouth	Light green	bronchioles	purple
pharynx	orange	alveoli	yellow
larynx	Dark green	diaphragm	red
trachea	Light blue	lung	pink
