

Lobster Boat Coloring Page

You can't get to your lobster traps without a boat! In the early days of lobstering, small wooden row boats called dories were used to haul traps by hand. Today's lobster boats are powered by diesel engines and are made of fiberglass. Most are between 20-40 feet and have a windshield and wheel house to keep the captain and crew as safe and as dry as possible. Boats are often named for friends, family, or loved ones, but can also have cool names like "Retrireve-ah", "Calypso", or "Phoenix". Be sure give your boat a good name and a good paint job! Color in the boat and ocean wave, cut them out, and place them with the other items on a wall or door to make a BIG lobstering scene!
