Obama Administration Broke the Law by Freeing 5 Taliban Terrorists in Exchange for Sgt. Bowe Bergdahl.

The GAO, Government Accountability Office, issued a report that concluded that the Obama Administration broke federal law when it released five Taliban prisoners from GITMO in exchange for Bowe Bergdahl without notifying Congress in advance. According to the GAO, the Pentagon violated the 2014 Department of Defense Appropriations Act when it transferred five senior Taliban prisoners to Qatar without providing at least 30 days notice to certain congressional committees.
