

Stripe-headed Tanager

- Formerly called the Stripe-headed Tanager, taxonomists recently split the Stripe-headed Tanager into four separate species, based on differences in calls and in the plumages of both males and females.
 The Puerto Rican variety is now known as the Puerto Rican Spindalis
- It primarily eats berries and fruits such as figs, blackberries and Cecropia fruits, but will consume some aphids and other insects.
