- Can your child count the goats? Can they put the goats in the right order of size?
- Can they think of some good words to describe their troll?
- Your child could build their own bridge at home using bricks or lego.
- Encourage language skills and recall by encouraging your child to retell the story using their puppets.
- Perhaps they could make up a different version of the story. Have lots of fun!
