



Flag of Denmark - Dannebrog Adopted in 1748. Versions in use since at least c. 1400. A red field charged with a white cross extending to the edges; the vertical part of the cross is shifted to the hoist side. Dimensions: 3:1:3 width / 3:1:4.5 to 3:1:5.25 length. The cross represents Christianity. The design of the Dannebrog is recorded on a seal from 1397.
