



Flag of Ecuador - La Tricolor (The Tricolor)

First adopted on 1835 and later on September 26, 1860.

The flag derived from the flag of Gran Colombia. The red in the Ecuador flag represents the blood shed by the soldiers and martyrs in the battles for independence. The color blue stands for the color of the sea and sky; while the yellow symbolizes the abundance and fertility of the nation's crops and land.
