



Flag of Greenland - Erfalasorput ("our flag"), Aappalaartoq ("the red")

Adopted on June 21, 1985. Designed by Thue Christiansen. A horizontal bicolor of white and red, with a counterchanged disk slightly off-centre towards the hoist. The large white part in the flag symbolizes the ice cap and fjords are represented by the red part in the circle. The white part of the circle symbolizes the ice bergs and the pack ice, and the large red part in the flag represents the ocean.
