



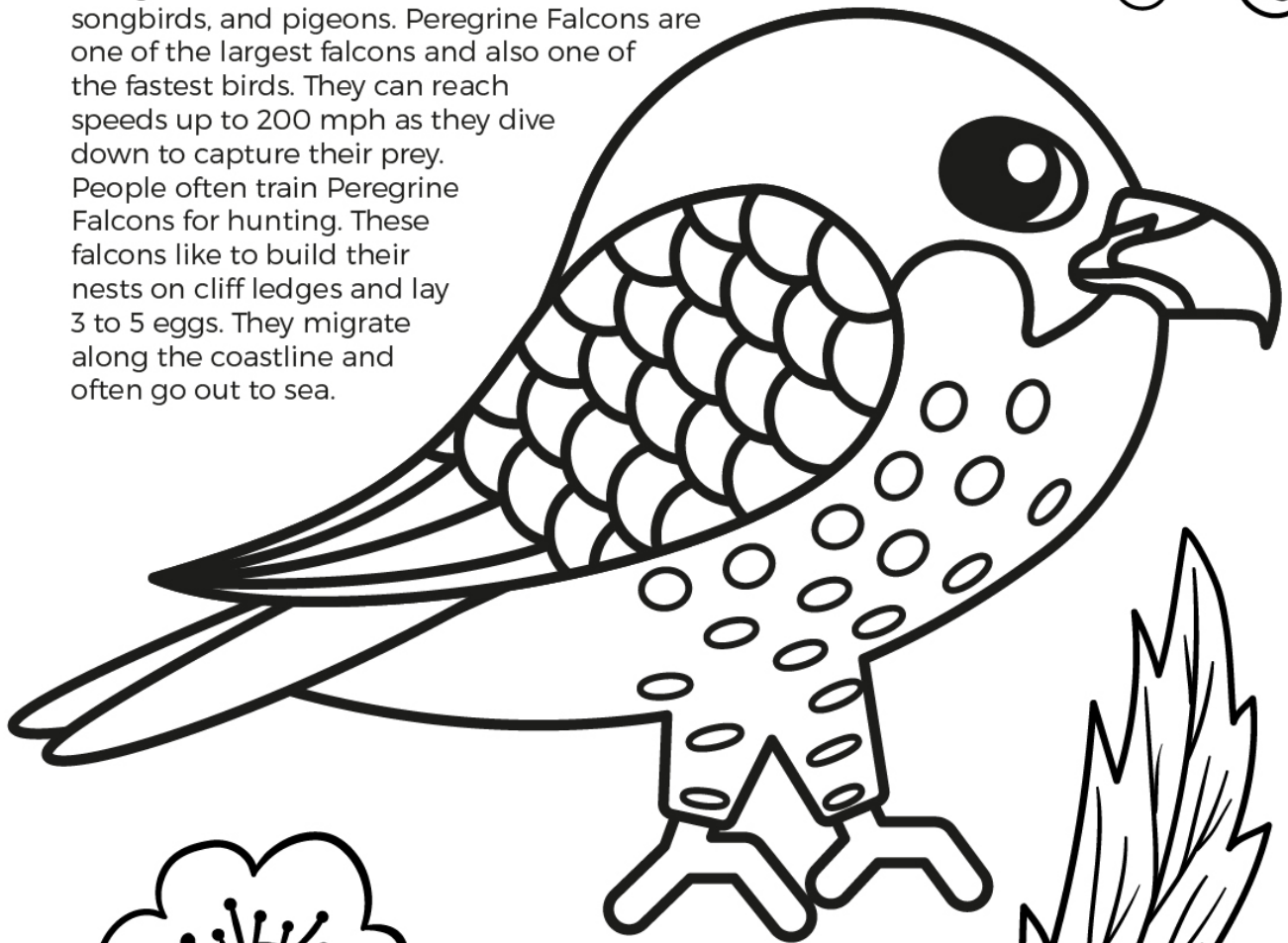
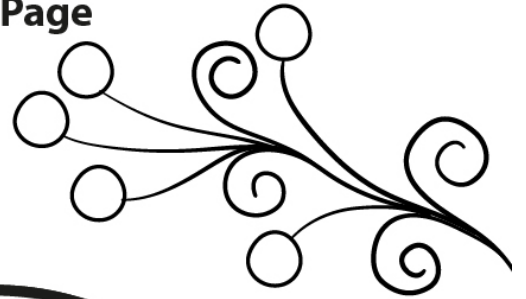
PEREGRINE FALCON

People often train Peregrine Falcons for hunting. These falcons like to build their nests on cliff ledges and lay 3 to 5 eggs. They migrate along the coastline and often go out to sea.
