Barn owls are found in North and South America, Africa, Europe, Arabian Peninsula, Indonesia and Australia. They live in plains, grassland and woodlands. Hunting usually starts at dusk and continues on during the night. The main prey is rodents such as mice, rats and voles. They also eat birds, reptiles and insects depend on the environment of their habitat.

The size is about 30 to 40cm (13 to 16in) in length and the wing span is about 100 to 125cm (39 to 49 in). The face is white and the body is white with little black spots. The upper part of the wings has varied colors such as black, grey, brown, orange and yellow. The inside of the wings is white with black broken stripes.
