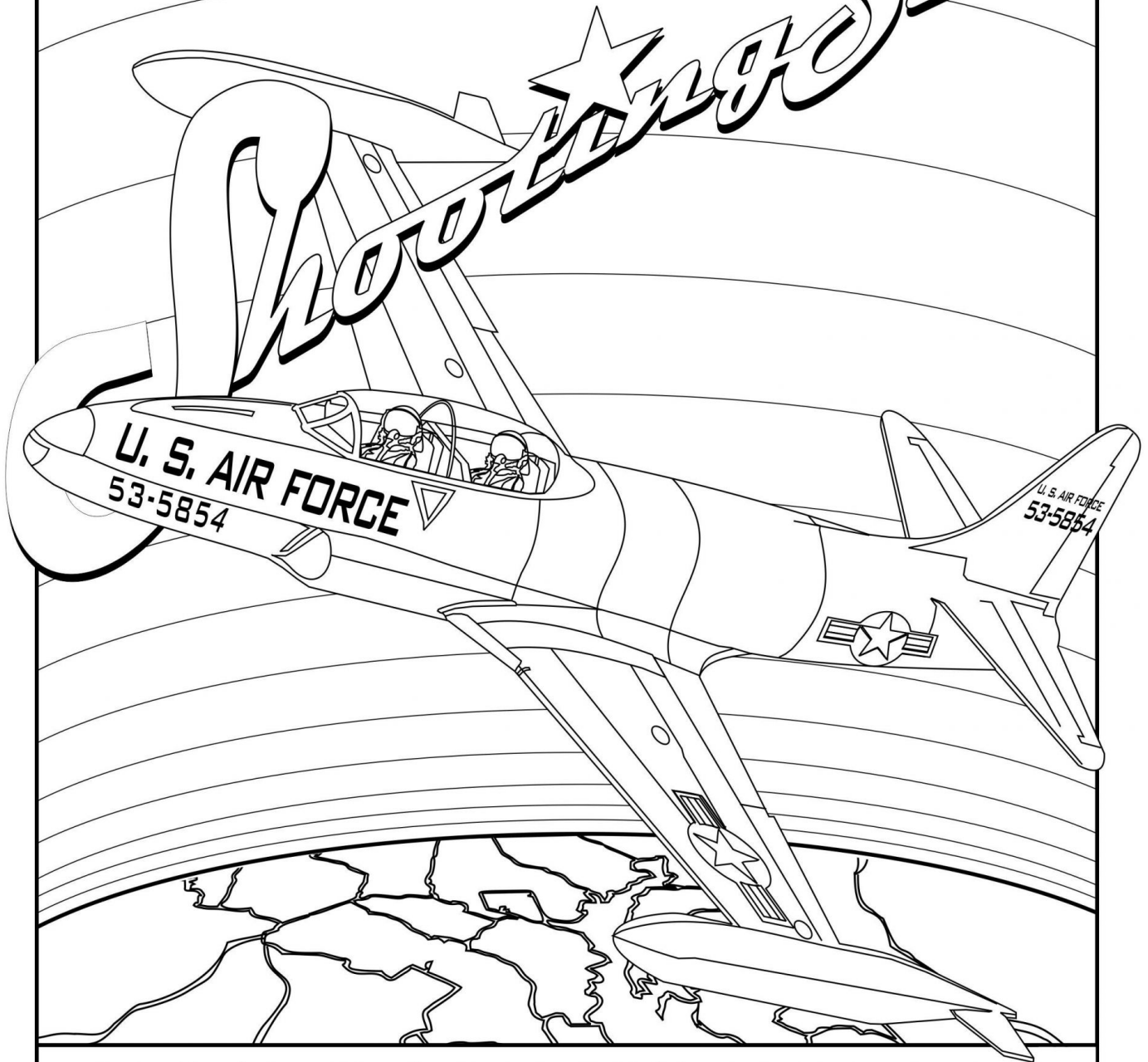


# Lockheed T-33

# Shooting Star



The Lockheed T-33 "Shooting Star" (or T-Bird) is a twin-jet, American trainer aircraft. Originally designated as the P-80, its first flight took place in 1944. The P-80 became the first jet fighter to enter full squadron service in the United States Army Air Forces as the T-33. Tail number 53-5854 is currently on display at the Martin Museum, Martin State Airport, in Middle River, Maryland.
