Sandhill Crane Migration



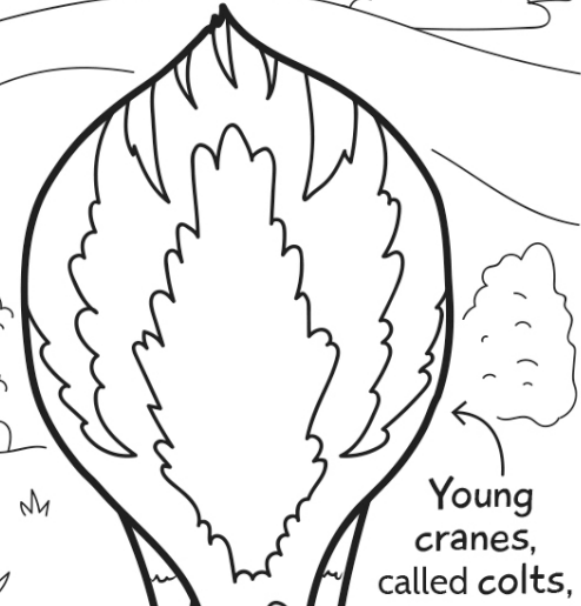
