



The Tuojiangosaurus was the best-known plated dinosaur from China. On its back were fifteen pairs of pointed plates and on the end of its tail were

two pairs of spikes—similar to the Stegosaurus. These four-ton plant eaters measured twenty-three-feet long and stood seven-feet high.
