

# Giant Oarfish (*Regalecus glesne*)

Length: Up to 56 feet

Weight: Up to 600 lb

Diet: Plankton

- World's longest bony fish
- Deep sea fish found around 3,300 ft
- Eat small plankton
- Not dangerous to humans
- Do not have scales, making their skin easily damaged
- Very rare. Information gathered has been from dead or dying fish that float up to the surface
